

CALL FOR 2nd ENEOLI TRAINING SCHOOL ON LEXICAL INNOVATION

14-17 April 2026 - Bucharest

Who can apply?

The training school is designed for PhD students, Post-Docs and Early Career Researchers (up to 5 years after obtaining their PhD) who wish to get a deeper understanding of lexical innovation through the school's innovative and interdisciplinary approach. We welcome participants from diverse backgrounds, particularly those involved in or beginning to engage in research projects focused on aspects of lexical innovation involving **semantic change** or the role of **neology in societal discourses**. During the training, each participant will also be encouraged to share their perspectives and concerns related to different dimensions of lexical innovation.

Bursaries

Applicants may be eligible for reimbursement to support their participation in the Training School, in accordance with [COST Action guidelines](#):

- The final grant amount, averaging approximately €800, is intended to cover accommodation and subsistence expenses during the Training School. Additionally, travel costs will also be reimbursed,
- Trainees are expected to cover their travel, accommodation, and subsistence expenses upfront, before receiving the grant, and will be reimbursed afterwards.

How to apply?

Applications should include the following:

1. A concise CV that includes the date of receipt of your academic degrees.
2. A one-page motivation letter outlining your project or interest in lexical innovation and explaining concretely how attending the Training School would benefit your work.

The deadline for the submission of applications is **the 15th of February**. The notification of acceptance or rejection will be sent by **the 25th of February** at the latest.
